ARTIST PORTFOLIO · GABRIELE KÜNNE

The sculptor and installation artist Gabriele Künne takes the rational dispositives of modern cities and landscapes as her starting point. Using planning scenarios and associative experimental systems she negotiates in her works the complex influences of technology and industry on the contemporary praxis of appropriation of nature and public space. In exemplarily designed systems she scrutinizes the various methods of the planner. Various phenomena of the rationalization of perception and knowledge permeate each other in a combination of both familiar and highly artificial artistic means. In this way textual images, in which mental reservations and perceptual criteria are articulated, are presented along with the tactile treatment of architectural volumes and urban structures. From this permeation Gabriele Künne lets associative systems of forms arise that present themselves to the viewer on several different levels and operate with spatial semiotic systems, material, format, size, and arrangement.

The telegraph pole, which has found its permanent place of installation in Otterbach / Kaiserslautern, does not rise quite as far into the sky as its original model, but also on it are three steel cross members, which are fastened one above the other to the mast. Unlike the old telegraph poles, however, there are no white porcelain insulators on the vertically mounted brackets. Instead, Gabriele Künne has rotated, deformed and deformed a whole canon of stone-shaped masses from the cylindrical shape of the insulators. The original uniformity of the insulators is modified by grooves, dents and bulges, some are further up and narrower down, others are bell-shaped, conical or twisted. Just as a telephone call (for which this type of telegraph pole had been developed) can sometimes be positive, sometimes negative, sometimes factual, sometimes emotional, the artist says that the forms are created as well.

The work was created in 2015 as part of the 10th Sculpture Symposium Rhineland-Palatinate and is located on Stellwerkmuseum Otterbach .



Rolled out, folded, rolled, thrown. A concentrated preparation combined with a short moment that determines the result. Make an incision and strike. Since 2008 ceramics have formed a new field in Gabriele Künne's work. But her use of ceramics, one of the oldest cultural techniques, does not result in sculpted figures or thrown pots. Instead, the material is worked from a technoid perspective - fingerprints and personal traces of the work process are avoided. Decisions and quick actions fix the moment in the material, which is pushed to the limits its constructive possibilities.
